The Organising Authority is the **Waimakariri Sailing Club Inc.** (WSC), Kaiapoi.

1. Rules

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020*.
- 1.2. The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part 1 shall apply.
- 1.3. For protests where a rule of Part 2 or Rule 31 is alleged to have been broken an arbitration hearing will be offered prior to any formal hearing.

2. Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1. The regatta is open to all boats of the Zephyr, Europe, New Zealand Moth, and Splash classes.
- 2.2. Other boats measuring 11 feet (3.35 metres) e.g. International Moths, are eligible to enter the Open Handicap series.
- 2.3. All entrants must be financial members of a club recognised by the entrant's national authority.
- 2.4. The entry fee for is \$20 per boat.
- 2.5. Eligible boats may enter by submitting a completed entry form to mike.and.janette@snap.net.nz or at registration. The entry fee will be collected at registration.

4. Sailing Instructions

The Sailing Instructions will be available at Registration.

5. Racing Area

Races will be sailed on the Waimakariri River near the WSPBC Club House.

6. Courses

Courses will be displayed on a whiteboard in the WSPBC Clubrooms and described by the Race Officer during the briefing.

7. Scoring

7.1. Three races are required to constitute a series.

7.2. When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores

7.3. When 5 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

8. Measurement

All boats, except the "Open" shall conform to their respective class rules and may be checked by a class measurer at any time.

9. Canteen Service

Canteen services will be available throughout the regatta with: Barbecue, pies, pizza, muffins, drinks and snacks.

10. Insurance

Each participating boat shall be responsible for their own insurance. As a minimum, a current third party policy should be held.

11. Disclaimer of Liability

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the Regatta.
