1. Rules

- **1.1.** The regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing* 2017-2020.
- **1.2.** The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part 1 shall apply.
- **1.3.** For protests where a rule of Part 2 or Rule 31 is alleged to have been broken an arbitration hearing will be offered prior to any formal hearing.

2. Eligibility and Entry

- **2.1.** The regatta is open to sailors under 19 years of age at the start of the regatta for Optimist, P Class and Starling and Firebug classes
- **2.2.** All entrants must be financial members of a club recognised by the entrant's national authority.
- **2.3.** The entry fee for is \$10 per entrant.
- **2.4.** Eligible boats may enter by submitting a completed entry form to mike.and.janette@snap.net.nz or at registration. The entry fee will be collected at registration.

Courses will be displayed on a whiteboard in the WSPBC Clubrooms and described by the Race Officer during the briefing.

7. Scoring

- **7.1.** Two races are required to constitute a series.
- 8. All races shall count towards scoring

9. Measurement

- **9.1.** Firebug Class: All boats shall conform to either the current 'FBHQ Class Rules', or the current FBHQ Class Rules as changed by the 'South Island Firebug Group 2009 amendments'. Boats may be checked by the Class measurers at any time.
- **9.2.** Optimist, P Class and Starling, class boats may be checked by a class measurer at any time.

10. Prizes and classes

10.1. North Canterbury Championship Trophies will be awarded for Optimist, P, Starling, and Junior Firebug class winners.

11. Canteen Service
