Here are the sailing instructions for the WSC Novelty Sailing Event.
Additional instructions will be given at the skippers briefing.

1. Rules.

1.1. The Novelty Events Day will be run according to our published Sailing Instructions and the Sailing Safety Procedures.

2. Eligibility and Entry.

2.1. This event day is for WSC members and their guests.

2.2. Registrations for entry will be taken on the day.

2.3. No entry fee.

3. Schedule.

3.1. A skippers briefing will be held at 10:00hrs.

3.2. Each event to take approximately 25-30 minutes.

4. Sailing Instructions and Course.

4.1. The event will be held at our regular sailing venue.

4.2. Additional sailing instructions will be given at the skippers briefing.

4.3. The general course outline and intention is given in appendix 1 to 3.

An additional event may be added on the day depending on wind conditions, fleet numbers and fleet composition.

The courses are drawn assuming a Easterly wind.

5. Safety.

5.1. The Race Officer will make the decision on the river, weather or wind conditions being suitable for each event to start or to continue.

This day is based on there being a light Easterly wind.

5.2. If there is a warning signal of six or more short horn blasts all boats must come ashore as quickly as possible.

5.3. We will need to crew two support boats.

6. Other matters.

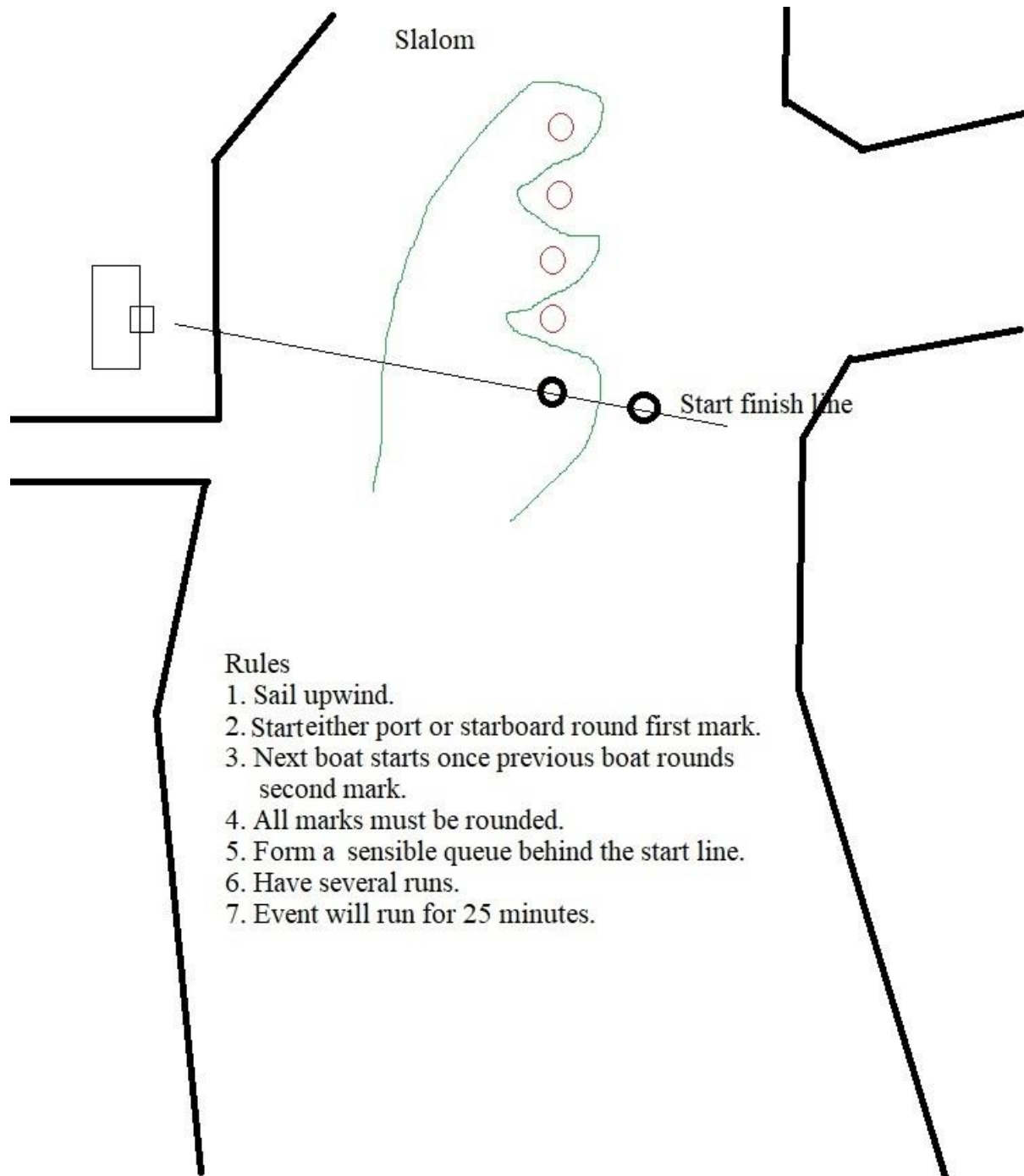
6.1. Extra onshore help will be required to launch and retrieve yachts and to assist with some events. Contact me for details.

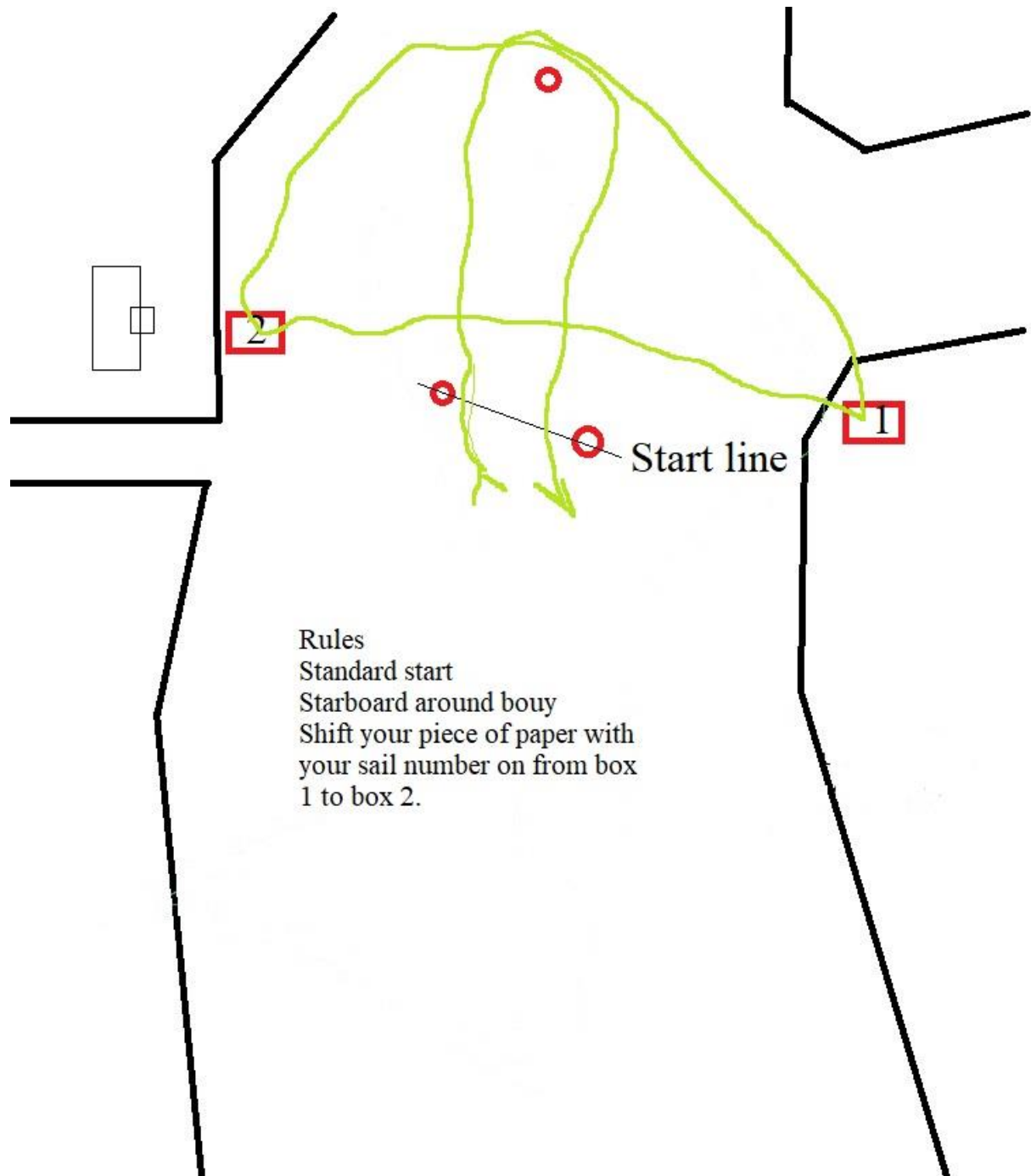
Appendix 1



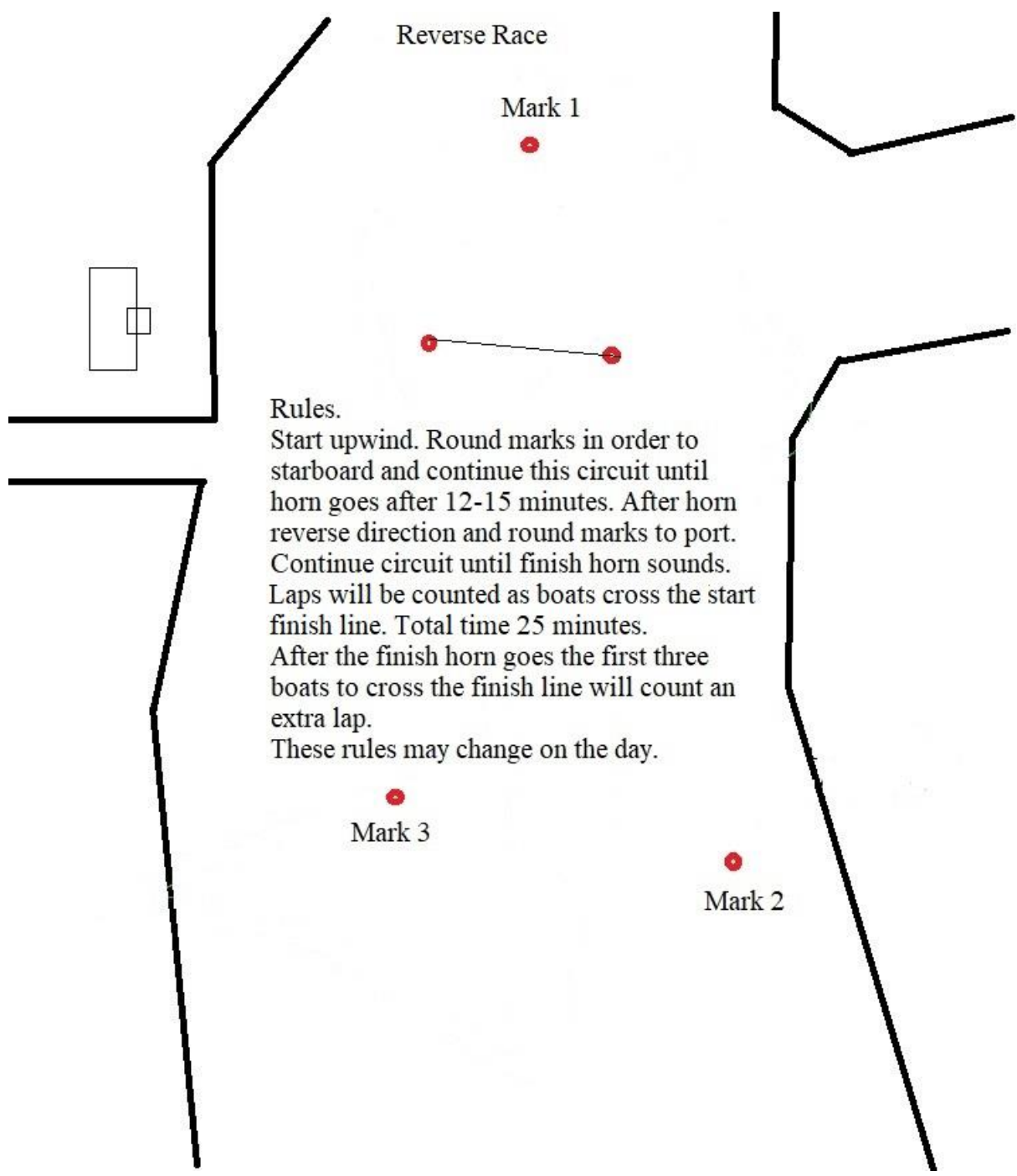
Rules

1. Sail upwind.
2. Start either port or starboard round first mark.
3. Next boat starts once previous boat rounds second mark.
4. All marks must be rounded.
5. Form a sensible queue behind the start line.
6. Have several runs.
7. Event will run for 25 minutes.

Reverse Race

Mark 1



Rules.
Start upwind. Round marks in order to starboard and continue this circuit until horn goes after 12-15 minutes. After horn reverse direction and round marks to port. Continue circuit until finish horn sounds. Laps will be counted as boats cross the start finish line. Total time 25 minutes. After the finish horn goes the first three boats to cross the finish line will count an extra lap. These rules may change on the day.
